


The African Continent / The Middle East / The Indian Ocean



*1) SAUDI ARABIA (a) Persian/Arabian Gulf coast (b) Red Sea coast – excluding transits This exclusion shall not apply where the vessels or craft are transiting the waters claimed by Saudi Arabia as their territorial waters as long as whilst transiting such vessels or craft shall not call at any port or place or interrupt their passage to engage in the transfer of cargo, stores, personnel or the like.

*2) Persian or Arabian Gulf and adjacent waters including the Gulf of Oman and waters west of the line from Oman's territorial limit off Cape al-Hadd at 22° 42.5'N, 59° 54.5'E northeast to the Iran-Pakistan border at 25° 10.5'N, 61° 37.5'E, excepting coastal waters of adjoining territories up to 12 nautical miles offshore unless otherwise provided.

*3 This area shall not include any installations in the above area which are in the territorial waters, out to 12 nautical miles, of Islands, Dependencies or Countries which are not owned by Venezuela
